TO THE HONORABLE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

Gentlemen:

I believe that the following Annual Report for the year 1968 is self-explanatory.

The gross cost of operation of this department increased from \$2,171,159.27 in 1967 to \$3,559,289.20 the past year. The net cost increased from \$641,646.83 in 1967 to \$939,261.97.

The greatest increase in cost once again occurred in the Medicaid Program with the next greatest increase being in the Aid to Dependent children program.

The prospects for reducing costs in the future appear brighter with the enactment of the new amendments to the Social Services Laws as passed by the 1969 Legislature.

We shall continue to keep the costs at a minimum in this Agency.

I wish to thank the members of the Board of Supervisors for the salary increases and the additional fringe benefits granted to us during the past year. And to the members of the various committees of the Board with whom I have worked I wish to express my sincere appreciation for their continued understanding of the many problems with which we are confronted.

I also appreciate the cooperation which we have received from city, town, village and other county departments and officials.

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The average number of recipients of Old Age Assistance in 1968 was 174 per month compared to 169 in 1967. The gross cost of this program decreased from \$148,495.30 to \$148,255.54, while the net cost to the county in 1967 was \$24,085.97 while in 1968 it was \$17,721.74.

The average caseload in this category increased from 92 representing 392 persons in 1967 to 131 per month representing 527 persons in 1968. The gross cost increased from \$122,136.46 to \$171,814.70 while the net cost to the county was \$60,265.48 in 1967 compared to \$83,395.15 in 1968.

The above gross amount includes over \$200,000.00 remaining from 1967 which was paid in 1968. Compared with the above 1968 gross figure, the gross amount expended in 1967 was \$933,817.92. The net cost to the county last year was \$490,002.97, while in 1967 it was \$333,337.94. The total cost average per month during the first six months of 1968 was approximately \$151,000.00, while during the last six months it dropped to \$125,000.00. The first four months of this year (1969) the cost has dropped considerably below \$125,000.00 and with the reduction in eligibility which was passed by this year's legislature it would appear that the cost of this program will continue to decrease substantially.

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CHILD WELFARE DIVISION (FOSTER CARE)

The total monthly caseload in this division ranged from a low of 154 children to a high of 212 compared to a high of 154 and a low of 113 in 1967.

The number of children in Foster Homes in 1968 ranged from a low of 88 to a high of 112 compared to a low of 77 and a high of 96 in 1967.

The number of referrals to this division decreased from 290 in 1967 to 280 in 1968. The greatest number of referrals came from Court, 78, Families, 72, Schools, 43, with the remainder coming from our Public Assistance Division, out of county, private citizens and other sources.

There were 31 unmarried mothers referred also for advice and services.
