

Calendar for March Village Elections

March 18, 2020

December 2	First day to sign party designating petitions.
December 31	First day to sign independent nominating petitions.
January 6- 13	Dates for filing party designating petitions.
January 7- 14	Dates to publish notice of party caucus in newspaper. (Not earlier than 2 weeks before caucus or later than 1 week before caucus)
January 13- 21	Last day to post & file notice of party caucus with the village clerk & county board of elections. (At least 10 days before caucus)
January 13 - 21	Dates to post notice of party caucus in 6 public places. (At least 10 days before caucus)
January 21 - 28	Dates for holding a party caucus.
January 23 – 30	Dates for filing certificate of party nomination.
January 28	Village Primary Day (if necessary)
February 4 - 11	Dates for filing independent nominating petitions.
March 6	Last day to register with the county board of elections to be eligible to vote in the village election.
March 18	Election Day – polls open noon to 9pm
March 19	Board of Elections canvass/certify results.

Chittenango Mayor - 4 yr term, Trustees (2) - 4 yr term
Earlville Trustees (2) - 2 yr term

Registration by Mail: Forms for Registration by mail may be obtained at the Board of Elections or downloaded at www.madisoncounty.ny.gov/boe

Forms are also available at the Post Office and the Village and Town Clerk's offices. The registration must be received at the Board of Elections by March 10, 2017.

Absentee Voting: If a qualified voter will be absent from Madison County on Election Day, absentee ballots are available. An absentee application (available at the website or by calling the Board of Elections) must be on file at the BOE before a ballot is mailed to the voter. Absentee ballots for a Village Election must be postmarked by the day before the election and received by 9pm Election Day.

Financial Disclosure Filing Dates:

Feb 17 (32 days before election)
Mar 10 (11 days before election)
Apr 17 (27 days after election)

Candidates spending or receiving over \$1,000 are required to file the financial disclosure reports (dates above) and register with the State Board of Elections. Village candidates spending or receiving less than \$1,000 will file a **CF-05** (Claim of Exemption) with the County Board of Elections.
