

Do you want to know if your car seat is in safely?

Call the New York State Police to make an appointment to have your car seat checked by a child passenger safety technician.

As of November 24, 2009, NYS law requires all children under 8 years old riding in a passenger vehicle to be restrained in a car seat or booster seat. For more information on this law, visit safeny.ny.gov

Take these steps to help keep your child safe

- ★ Keep infants rear-facing until they are 2 years old or until they can no longer fit in a rear-facing car seat.
- ★ Keep children in a five point harness until they are at least 4 years old and at least 40 pounds.
- ★ Keep children in a booster seat until they properly fit in a seat belt, which is usually when they weigh 100 pounds and are 4-feet 9-inches tall.
- ★ Put children 12 and under in the back seat.
- ★ Do not use a child safety seat that is more than six years old.
- ★ Do not purchase a used car seat.
- ★ Mail in the car seat registration postcard so you will be informed of recalls.

**You may be eligible
for the program if you:**

1. Live in Madison County,
2. Are the parent or guardian of the child the seat is for,
3. Are on WIC or Medicaid, and
4. Do not have an appropriate car seat.

Call the location nearest you to determine if you are eligible and to schedule an appointment.

Trained staff will show you how your child should fit and teach you how to install it correctly.

If you are pregnant, please make your appointment in your seventh or eighth month.
