- INSTRUCTIONS:**
- (1) Mark only with a pen or felt tip marker having blue or black ink.
  - (2) To vote for a candidate whose name is printed on this ballot, completely fill in the oval next to the name of the candidate.
  - (3) To vote for a person whose name is not printed on this ballot write or stamp his or her name in the space labeled "write-in" that appears at the bottom of the column for such office.
  - (4) Any other mark or writing, or any erasure made on this ballot outside the voting oval or "write-in" box provided for voting will void this entire ballot.
  - (5) Do not over-vote. If you select a greater number of candidates than there are vacancies to be filled, your ballot will be void for that office.

- (6) If you tear, or deface, or wrongly mark this ballot, contact the Board of Elections at (315) 366-2231 or [boecommissioners@madisoncounty.ny.gov](mailto:boecommissioners@madisoncounty.ny.gov) for instructions on how to obtain a new ballot. Do not attempt to correct mistakes on the ballot by making erasures or cross outs. Erasures or cross outs may invalidate all or part of your ballot. Prior to submitting your ballot, if you make a mistake in completing the ballot or wish to change your ballot choices, you may obtain and complete a new ballot. You have a right to a replacement ballot upon the return of the original ballot.
- (7) Enclose the voted ballot in the ballot envelope and sign and date the back of the envelope where indicated.
- (8) Seal the ballot envelope in the envelope addressed to the Board of Elections.
- (9) Mail immediately.
- (10) The ballot of the voter must be received at the Board of Elections on or before 9:00pm March 18, 2020.
