



Madison County Maternal Child Health Program

How does the program work?

One of our friendly and experienced Maternal Child Health nurses will contact you within 24 hours of receiving your referral. Your nurse will make arrangements to meet with you in your home, or another convenient location, such as your local library. She will continue to meet with you monthly as you prepare for labor and delivery of your baby. She will then meet with you and your baby once you have delivered. The cost is covered through insurance.

How can the program help me & my baby?

Your nurse will connect you with community resources such as WIC, Healthy Families, and childbirth classes, provide tips for staying healthy and for getting breastfeeding off to a good start, teach you about signs of labor and danger signs, give support, and answer your questions.

What services does the program offer?

- Help you find relief with common complaints of pregnancy
- Answer your infant care and parenting questions
- After delivery, check your baby's weight and growth milestones
- Offer you breastfeeding support
