Madison County COVID-19 Website Gets an Upgrade

Wampsville, NY – The Madison County Health Department (MCDOH) today announced updates to the COVID-19 data on their [website](#). You will see some of the same graphs and maps, but now they have an interactive feature.

Health Statistician, Erica Bird, has worked hard over the past few weeks with the program Tableau to create the new look. The Madison County map shows the same numbers, active, deaths, total positives, and recovered, but now you can click on each township and see the numbers for that area. The demographic graphs, total tests graph, and the reopening metrics are interactive as well.

“Throughout the COVID-19 pandemic we here at Madison County have worked to provide our residents with the most up-to-date and accurate information that we can,” said Public Health Director Eric Faisst. “As we continue to recover and reopen our community we anticipate we may have hotspots. This new interactive map and graphs will help us here at the Health Department as well as our members of the community to track that data.”
