1. Mark only with a black pen.
2. To vote for a candidate whose name is printed on this ballot, fill in the oval above or to the left of the name of the candidate.
3. To vote for a person whose name is not printed on this ballot, write or stamp his or her name in the space labeled "Write-in" at the bottom of the column for such office.
4. Any other mark or writing, or any erasure made on this ballot outside the voting ovals or blank spaces provided for voting may void this entire ballot.

5. Do not overvote. If you mark a greater number of candidates than there are vacancies to be filled, your vote will be void for that race.
6. Do not tear, or deface, or otherwise mark the ballot. If you need instructions on how to obtain a new ballot, call the Board of Elections at 315-533-2231 or contact the Board of Elections at 315-533-2231 or visit the Board of Elections website at www.madisonny.gov. Do not attempt to correct mistakes on a ballot by using erasable markers or crossing out. Erasures or crossing out may invalidate all or part of your ballot. Prior to signing your name, if you make a mistake while completing the ballot or wish to change your ballot choices, you may obtain and complete a new ballot. You have a right to a replacement ballot.

7. To count absentee ballots returned by mail must be postmarked no later than the day of the election.
8. After marking the ballot, enclose it in the envelope bearing the voter's statement, and seal the envelope.
9. Fill in the blanks in the statement and sign your name.
10. Place the sealed envelope bearing the ballot in the envelope addressed to the County Board of Elections and mail promptly.
