Instructions

1. Mark only with a black pen.
2. To vote for a candidate whose name is printed on this ballot, fill in the oval above or next to the name of the candidate.
3. To vote for a person whose name is not printed on this ballot, write or stamp his or her name in the space labeled "Write-in" at the bottom of the column for such office.
4. Any other mark or writing, or any erasure made on this ballot outside the voting ovals or blank spaces provided for voting may void this entire ballot.

5. Do not overfill. If you select a greater number of candidates than there are vacancies, your ballot will be void for that office.

6. If you test or deface or wrongly mark this ballot, call the Board of Election Commissioners at 361-366-2231 or 361-366-2232. After marking the ballot, place it in the envelope bearing the voter's statement, and seal the envelope.

7. Do not attempt to correct mistakes on the ballot by making erasures or scribbles. Erasures or cross outs may void the ballot. Fill in properly the ballot in the statement and sign your name.

8. If you make a mistake in completing the ballot, you may void the ballot. Enclose the sealed envelope bearing the ballot in the envelope addressed to the County Board of Election Commissioners.

9. If you wish to change your ballot choices, you may obtain a replacement ballot. You have the right to a replacement ballot.
