Official Absentee Ballot for the General Election - November 3, 2020

Instructions

1. Mark only with a black pen.
2. To vote for a candidate whose name is printed on this ballot, fill in the oval above or next to the name of the candidate.
3. To vote for a person whose name is not printed on this ballot, write or stamp his or her name in the space labeled "Write-in" at the bottom of the column for such office.
4. Any other mark or writing, or any erasure made on this ballot outside the voting ovals or blank spaces provided for voting may void this entire ballot.

5. Do not overvote. Select a greater number of candidates than there are vacancies to be filled, and your vote will be void for that office.

If you tear, or deface, or wrongly mark this ballot, call the Board of Elections at 360-2231 or email boardofelections@madisoncountyny.gov for instructions on how to obtain a replacement ballot. Do not attempt to correct mistakes on the ballot by making erasures or cutouts. Erasures or cutouts may invalidate all or part of your ballot. Prior to submitting your ballot, you make a mistake in completing the ballot, you wish to change your ballot choices, you may obtain a complete replacement ballot. You have a right to a replacement ballot.

To be counted, absentee ballots returned by mail must be postmarked no later than the day of the election.

After marking the ballot, place it in the envelope bearing the voter's statement, and seal the envelope.

Fill in properly the blank space on the statement and sign your name.

Enclose the sealed envelope bearing the ballot in the envelope addressed to the County Board of Elections and return it to the County Board of Elections.
