Official Absentee Ballot for the General Election - November 3, 2020 County of Madison

Instructions

1. Mark only with a black pen.
2. To vote for a candidate whose name is printed on this ballot, fill in the oval next to the name of the candidate.
3. To vote for a person whose name is not printed on this ballot, write or stamp his or her name in the space labeled "Write-in" at the bottom of the column for such office.
4. Any other mark or writing, or any erasure made on this ballot outside the voting ovals or blank spaces provided for voting may void this entire ballot.

Do not overvote. You select a greater number of candidates than the number of vacancies to be filled, your vote will be void for that office.

If you tear, or deface, or wrongly mark the ballot, call the Board of Elections at 312-2231 or 312-2232 for instructions on how to obtain a new ballot.

To correct mistakes on this ballot by using erasors or cross outs. Erasures or cross outs may void your ballot. Prior to marking your ballot, if you make a mistake while completing the ballot, you may wish to change your ballot choice. You may only change your ballot choice once and complete a new ballot. You have one chance to place your ballot.

7. This county, absentee ballots returned by mail must be postmarked no later than the day of election.

8. Attach the ballot, enclose it in the envelope bearing the voter's statement, and seal the envelope.

9. Fill in the blanks in the statement and sign your name.

10. Place the sealed envelope bearing the ballot in the envelope addressed to the County Board of Elections and mail promptly.
