Official Absentee Ballot for the General Election - November 3, 2020
Instructions
 1. Mark only with a black pen.
 2. To vote for a candidate whose name is printed on this ballot, fill in the oval above or next to the name of the candidate.
 3. To vote for a person whose name is not printed on this ballot, write or stamp his or her name in the space labeled "Write-in" at the bottom of the column for such office.
 4. Any other mark or writing, or any erasure made on this ballot outside the voting ovals or blank spaces provided for voting may void this entire ballot.

County of Madison
 Do not overvote. If you select a greater number of candidates than the vacancies to be filled, your ballot will be void for that office.
 Do not alter, deface, or write on this ballot. Call the Registrar of Elections at 315-300-31 or boecoe@madisoncountymn.gov for instructions on how to obtain a new ballot. Do not attempt to correct mistakes on this ballot by making erasures, crossing out measures or words. Invalidations or part of your ballot may result in your ballot not being counted. If you make a mistake completing the ballot or wish to change your choices, you may obtain and complete a new ballot. You have a right to a replacement ballot.

7. To be counted, absentee ballots returned by mail must be postmarked no later than the day of election.
 8. After marking the ballot, enclose it in the envelope bearing the voter's statement, and seal the envelope.
 9. Fill in properly the blanks in the statement and sign your name.
 10. Enclose the sealed envelope containing the ballot in the envelope addressed to the County Board of Elections. Mail properly.
