Potential Public Exposures to COVID-19 in Madison County

Wampsville, NY – Madison County Health Department has confirmed that individuals who visited various locations in Madison County tested positive for COVID-19. Members of the public who visited any of these places on the below dates should self-monitor for symptoms.

Symptom monitoring period: up to October 17, 2020

Tops Friendly Market

Time and Date of exposure: October 4, 2020 between 10:00 AM and 11:00 AM

Symptom monitoring period: up to October 18, 2020

Symptom monitoring period: up to October 18, 2020

Anyone who visited this location during the identified times should monitor themselves for symptoms of COVID-19. Those symptoms include fever, cough, chills, muscle pain, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea, and/or difficulty breathing. If symptoms develop, please stay home and contact your doctor for guidance on testing. In the event of an emergency, please call 911.
