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## **Potential Public Exposures to COVID-19 in Madison County**

**Wampsville, NY** – Madison County Health Department has confirmed that an individual who visited the Point Place Casino in Bridgeport, NY tested positive for COVID-19. Members of the public who visited the casino on the below dates should self-monitor for symptoms.

### **Point Place Casino**

Address: 450 NY-31, Bridgeport, NY 13030

Time and Date of exposure: September 25, 2020 between 12:00 AM and 2:00 AM and  
September 26, 2020 between 5:00 PM and 6:00 PM

Wore Mask: yes

Symptom monitoring period: up to October 8 and 9, 2020

Anyone who visited this location during the identified time frames should monitor themselves for symptoms of COVID-19. Those symptoms include fever, cough, chills, muscle pain, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea, and/or difficulty breathing. If symptoms develop, please stay home and contact your doctor for guidance on testing. In the event of an emergency, please call 911.

It is important that residents remain diligent and continue to do their part to limit the spread of COVID-19. Please protect yourself and others by wearing a face covering when you are out in public, especially when you are unable to maintain social distancing. Also, please practice good hygiene. These guidelines are for all of our protection to stop the spread of COVID-19 in our community.
