Mobile Testing Clinic --October 22 in Cazenovia and October 29 in Wampsville**

Wampsville, NY - Madison County Department of Health (MCDOH) announced today that SUNY Upstate Medical University is bringing their mobile testing clinic to Morrisville, NY. MCDOH is partnering with Upstate to offer a COVID-19 nasopharyngeal diagnostic tests by appointment.

Anyone who would like to be tested should **call 315-464-2582 select option 0 to set up an appointment.** Testing is available to anyone interested and at no cost to the patient.

“We wanted to provide afternoon hours to our residents, especially to those who work or go to school during the day,” said Madison County Public Health Director Eric Faisst. “Thank you to SUNY Upstate for bringing their mobile testing abilities to Madison County once again.”
