STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARATION

A State of Emergency is hereby declared in the County of Madison, State of New York effective at 12:00 p.m. on Monday, November 23, 2020.

This State of Emergency has been declared due to Coronavirus-19 (COVID-19), which the World Health Organization has designated as a world-wide pandemic. COVID-19 is an infection associated with fever and signs and symptoms of pneumonia or other respiratory illness, appears to be transmitted from person to person predominantly through droplet transmission, and if spread in the population could have significant public health consequences. Travel related cases and community contact transmission of COVID-19 have been documented throughout New York State and on March 7, 2020, Governor Andrew Cuomo, pursuant to Executive order 202 declared a disaster emergency in the State of New York.

As of November 22, 2020, there have been 814 Madison County residents inflicted by this virus with 18 residents ultimately succumbing to its affects. The situation continues to rapidly evolve, and the threat of this virus continues to be imminent to the citizens and visitors of Madison County. It is, therefore, necessary that Madison County continue its emergency response to this pandemic.

As the Chief Executive of Madison County, I, John M. Becker, Board of Supervisors Chair, exercise the authority given me under Article 2-B, Section 24 of the New York State Executive Law, for the purpose of procuring goods and services, and to render all required and available assistance to municipalities and school districts that is vital to the security, well-being, and health and safety of the citizens of Madison County.

This State of Emergency will remain in effect for thirty days or until rescinded or renewed by a subsequent order.

EMERGENCY ORDER

Local Emergency Order for: Madison County, NY:

I, John M. Becker, the Chief Executive of Madison County, NY, in accordance with a declaration of State of Emergency issued on November 23, 2020, and pursuant to Sections 24 and 25 of Article 2-B of New York State Executive Law, do hereby promulgate the following emergency orders and declare that these emergency orders are necessary to help aid in disaster relief efforts:

- **All available Madison County facilities, equipment, supplies, personnel, which shall include the temporary reassignment of county employees, shall be made available to the Madison County Department of Public Health and to the Madison County Office of Emergency Management in such manner as may be necessary or appropriate to cope with the COVID-19 emergency situation.**

The above emergency orders shall take effect at 12:00 pm on November 23, 2020 and shall remain in effect until 12:00 pm on November 28, 2020, unless otherwise rescinded.

The above emergency orders are necessary to provide for social distancing to safeguard the public health and welfare, and necessary to assist in the COVID-19 disaster effort. The orders are intended to comply with all state and federal laws, regulations, and executive orders, and shall be read and interpreted in such manner.

Failure to obey this order is a criminal offense, punishable by law under New York State Executive Law §24(5).
