



Fall 2021 Document Shredding Events

The Madison County Dept. of Solid Waste is hosting 2 Fall shredding events for Madison County residents. To ensure as many people as possible can be served, the department will enforce a MAXIMUM of 4 filing boxes per vehicle. **Business waste will not be accepted.**

- Residents must remain in their vehicle at ALL times.
- Keep material loose in boxes or paper bags. **NO PLASTIC BAGS.**
- Please have the boxes/paper bags easily accessible in the back of the vehicle for event staff to access them.

Accepted Materials: Medical documents, bank information, tax records, and other paperwork containing account numbers or private details are ideal for shredding. Staples/paperclips are fine.

Do **NOT** bring magazines, junk mail, phone books, or photographs. Please remove any non-paper items such as binders, plastic folders, thick metal or corrugated cardboard.
