

June 7, 2021

The regular monthly meeting called to order at 7:30 PM by Supervisor Stepanski with the following people present: Councilman Marshall, Meeker, Shea, Strain, Pete Kiehn and Dave Fort.

After the Pledge of Allegiance, minutes of the May 3 meeting was read and approved, on motion of Marshall/Meeker, all in favor. Financial reports for April and May were accepted on a motion of Marshall/Meeker. All in favor.

Supervisor Stepanski said he had paid Lisa Tifft directly from the Town \$300 rather than submit to the Town's Insurance company. The Board had met with Adam Shaver on May 11, after interviewing Shaver, the Board hired Shaver as the new Codes Enforcement Officer. Shaver's term will run 06/01/21-12/31/21. All in favor,

CEO Fort read his report. Motion made by Marshall/Meeker to accept his report, all in favor. Highway Superintendent Kiehn had nothing to report.

Supervisor Stepanski mentioned that he had met with Attorney Langey to review the PILOT Agreement and Host Community Benefit Agreement for the West Road Solar Farm. Stepanski said Langey was still working on the PILOT Agreement but had a proposed Host Community Benefit Agreement for the Board to review. Stepanski also had information on the NYS Adult Use Cannabis Law that allows municipalities to pass local laws and ordinances governing the time, place and manner of licensed cannabis retail dispensaries, the Town has until December 31, 2021 to decide.

Motion was made by Marshall/Meeker to pay bills. All in favor.

Supervisor Stepanski mentioned that he still did not have an exact figure on the amount of money the Town would be receiving from the Federal Government.

Meeting adjourned at 8:05 pm on motion of Marshall/Meeker. All in favor.
