

Qualifications of an Election Inspector

- ▶ Be a registered voter and a resident of Madison County.
- ▶ If you are 17 years old, you may be eligible if your school district participates in a program under Education Law Section 3207-a.
- ▶ Able to speak, read and write the English language.
- ▶ Be certified as an Inspector by the County Board of Elections after attending an official training class and passing a test (every year).
- ▶ Not hold any public elective office or be a candidate for any public office or party position to be voted on by voters of the district in which you will work.
- ▶ Not be a spouse, parent, or child of a candidate running for office in the district in which you will work.
- ▶ Be registered Democratic or Republican.
