

RESOLUTION NO. 22-\_\_\_\_\_

**AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR BROADBAND ENGINEERING SERVICES TO YES MICHIGAN PC, DBA "NEW YORK ENGINEERING SERVICES"**

**WHEREAS**, the Madison County Public Utility Committee ("Committee") issued a Request for Proposals (RFP P1-22) seeking Broadband Engineering Services to design, permit, and manage the construction of Madison County's Last-Mile Fiber-to-the-Premise (FTTP) Broadband network; and

**WHEREAS**, four proposals were received and evaluated by the Committee with YES Michigan PC, DBA "New York Engineering Services" (NYES) receiving the highest rating by consensus of the Committee; and

**WHEREAS**, in addition to the RFP ranking, the Committee also conducted an interview with YES, which further cemented our recommendation to work with NYES; and

**WHEREAS**, the anticipated cost of the services will be \$1,649,409 (not to exceed \$1,682, 397), which is within the budgeted scope of the awarded USDA Broadband ReConnect project; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with the USDA Broadband ReConnect project rules, the contract template will follow the required Rural Utilities Service (RUS) Engineering Services Contract Form 217 format; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes and directs the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors to execute a contract with YES Michigan PC, DBA "New York Engineering Services" (NYES), in substantially the same form as the copy now on file with the Clerk.
