

May 2, 2022

The regular monthly meeting called to order at 7:30 PM by Supervisor Stepanski with the following people present: Councilmen Fort, Marshall, Meeker, Adam Shaver and Pete Kiehn.

After the Pledge of Allegiance, minutes of the April 4<sup>th</sup> meeting were read and approved on motion of Marshall/Meeker, all in favor. Financial report was accepted on motion of Marshall/Meeker, all in favor.

Supervisor Stepanski mentioned that he had attended the Memorial Day planning meeting with the Village/Legion/Fire Department on April 27 and Mayor Mike LaLonde had mentioned that the Village was interested in purchasing a lighted/electronic sign board for the entrance to Carlon Field to replace the sign board that was currently there, it was decided that more information was needed: brightness/timer/size. Stepanski also said that he had received a quote from Bob Koen for replacing the sidewalk on the entrance to the municipal building and also along the right hand side of the building: \$10,232 and \$7,232 if the Town did the prep work. It was decided to get a couple more quotes and that the sidewalk in front of the building can be shortened.

CEO Shaver read his report, motion made by Marshall/Meeker to accept his report, all in favor. Councilman Marshall inquired into the ongoing issue on Cole Street and suggested it might be time to contact Attorney Langey to step in. Highway Superintendent Kiehn said paving did not get done in April due to weather and other factors, was hoping to complete in May. Kiehn also said the concrete blocks had been purchased for the short retaining wall on the front of the salt/sand storage building, he was still working on quotes for the generators and that he had a meeting with his highway committee regarding the purchase of a new utility trailer and had driven to SC to pick it up to save the cost of freight for the Town.

Stepanski had the audit reports for the Town Clerk/Water Collection/Tax Collector, all found to be satisfactory, motion made by Marshall/Meeker to accept the reports. All in favor.

Motion was made by Marshall/Meeker to pay bills. All in favor.

Meeting adjourned at 8:07 pm on motion of Marshall/Meeker. All in favor.
