The regular monthly meeting called to order at 7:30 PM by Supervisor Stepanski with the following people present: Councilmen Fort, Marshall, Meeker, Shea, Pete Kiehn, Adam Shaver and Joanne Shea.

After the Pledge of Allegiance, minutes of the October 3rd meeting was read and approved on motion of Marshall/Meeker, all in favor. Financial report was accepted on motion of Marshall/Shea, all in favor.

Councilman Marshall said he had received a phone call from a property owner that they had felt a blast from the quarry on 10/31 but had not received prior notification of blasting. The Town is supposed to receive prior notification as well and had not. Supervisor Stepanski said to notify Attorney Langey's office and they can inquire/pursue if the Samel's are in violation of their Special Use Permit.

Supervisor Stepanski had Deputy Celeste Smith's September report. Motion made by Marshall/Meeker to accept Smith's report, all in favor.

Public Hearing opened at 7:46 pm on motion of Marshall/Shea, all in favor, regarding Local Law No. 2-2022, titled, "A Local Law Updating the Code Enforcement Program In The Town of Stockbridge," no one to speak for or against. After a brief discussion, the public hearing closed at 7:54 pm on motion of Marshall/Meeker. All in favor. Public Hearing opened at 7:54 pm for the 2023 Town Budget on motion of Marshall/Meeker. No one to speak for or against it. Public Hearing closed at 7:57 pm on motion of Marshall/Meeker. All in favor.

Stepanski also had a Budget Mod to transfer monies. Motion made by Marshall/Meeker to accept the Budget Mod with a Roll Call Vote: Fort: Yes; Marshall: Yes; Meeker: Yes; Shea: Yes; Stepanski: Yes.

Motion was made by Marshall/Meeker to pay bills. All in favor.

Meeting adjourned at 8:17 pm on motion of Marsahall/Shea to adjourn, all in favor.
