Public Courtesy of the Floor-

We can send as an addendum, the list of things that we would like to be done that may help with resolution of the power outage problem. Once a government body becomes involved, action needs to be taken.

Neal Wilcox – Was inquiring about using a different skirting for his double wide that he is installing on his property. He presented samples of the new skirting. To be used the local law needs to be changed. Larry needs to speak with Town Attorney about how to allow the use of this product. State says that this skirting is allowed just needs to change local law to allow it.
