Supervisor Stepanski had Deputy Historian Celeste Smith's March report and also a report from Historian David Sadler. Motion made by Marshall/Shea to accept the reports, all in favor.

CEO Shaver was not present. Highway Superintendent Kiehn said the PGB had gone down and was hoping to pave by the end of April, Kiehn will contact Ulster Paving.

Supervisor Stepanski had the revised water agreement for the Jacobs water extension. Motion made by Marshall/Shea to accept the agreement with a Roll Call Vote: Fort: Yes; Marshall: Yes; Meeker: Yes; Shea: Yes; Stepanski: Yes.

Councilman Marshall mentioned he had attended court the night CEO Shaver had attended with the Cole Street property owner and it was decided to condemn the property and physically remove the tenant, if needed. The property owner would be responsible for all costs associated with the clean up of the property.

No action taken on the CEO Agreement. (Agreement signed but no motion made, action will be taken at the May meeting.)

Motion was made by Marshall/Fort to pay bills. All in favor.

Meeting adjourned at 8:00 pm on motion of Marshall/Meeker. All in favor.
