

September 11, 2023

The regular monthly meeting called to order at 7:30 PM by Supervisor Stepanski with the following people present: Councilman Fort, Marshall, Meeker, Shea, Pete Kiehn and Joanne Shea.

After the Pledge of Allegiance, minutes of the August 7 meeting was read and approved on motion of Marshall/Shea, all in favor. Financial report was accepted on a motion of Marshall/Meeker. All in favor.

Supervisor Stepanski had a letter from SVCS regarding an emergency evacuation drill to be held on Thursday, October 5th at Carlon Field. Stepanski also had the Fall hydrant flushing schedule from the City of Oneida for the Board to review.

Deputy Historian Smith submitted her report. Motion made by Marshall/Meeker to accept her report, all in favor. CEO Shaver submitted a report. Motion made by Marshall/Meeker to accept his report, all in favor. Highway Superintendent Kiehn reported they had been using a boom mower loaned to them by Madison County. Kiehn also had a price of \$11-14k for materials for the walking trail, all in favor of purchasing the materials. Kiehn also had a quote from Bob Koen for new concrete on the sidewalk/entrance way of \$8030. The Board approved Bob Koen doing the new concrete sidewalk/entrance way of \$8030 if the project can be done in the Fall. Kiehn also mentioned he had been exploring the hiring of a third full time employee.

Councilman Shea inquired into the van and truck that had been parking at the Stockbridge Town Park. Kiehn mentioned he had been in contact with the vehicle owner multiple times and if it continues, will be putting up no overnight parking signs.

Supervisor Stepanski had the reappointment of Thomas Jones Jr. to the Board of Assessment Review. Motion made by Marshall/Meeker to accept the reappointment, all in favor. Stepanski also mentioned that the Zoning Board was down three members and asked the Board for suggestions on replacements. Supervisor Stepanski also had a Budget Mod to transfer monies. Motion made by Marshall/Shea to accept the Budget Mod with a Roll Call Vote: Fort: Yes; Marshall: Yes; Meeker: Yes; Shea: Yes; Stepanski: Yes.

Motion made by Marshall/Meeker to pay bills. All in favor.

Meeting adjourned at 8:05 pm on motion of Marshall/Meeker. All in favor.
