

November 6, 2023

The regular monthly meeting called to order at 7:30 PM by Supervisor Stepanski with the following people present: Councilman Fort, Marshall, Meeker, Shea, Pete Kiehn and Joanne Shea.

After the Pledge of Allegiance, minutes of the October 2 meeting was read and approved with 2 changes on motion of Marshall/Meeker, all in favor. Financial report was accepted on a motion of Marshall/Shea. All in favor.

Supervisor Stepanski said he received a letter from SVCS thanking Highway Superintendent Kiehn and the Town for supporting and participating in the Evacuation Drill held on October 5th. Stepanski also had correspondence from Attorney Langey's office and the Attorney for Stockbridge Stone Products regarding the blast on September 13th. Stepanski also had an email from a concerned citizen regarding the vehicular accidents that have occurred at the intersection of Peterboro Road and Route 46 and the need for a traffic device. Highway Superintendent Kiehn will contact Madison County Highway and forward their email. Stepanski had another email regarding all the vandalism that has been occurring at Carlon Field, Kiehn said he had been in contact with the Sheriff's Department regarding a group of youth's that have been frequenting the park the last few months.

Public Hearing opened at 7:46 pm regarding Proposed Local Law #B of 2023, entitled "A Local Law Overriding The Tax Levy Limit Established in General Municipal Law 3-c". on motion of Marshall/Meeker. No one to speak for or against it. Public Hearing closed at 7:47 pm on motion of Marshall/Meeker. All in favor. Public Hearing opened at 7:47 pm for the 2024 Town Budget on motion of Marshall/Meeker. No one to speak for or against it. Public Hearing closed at 7:48 pm on motion of Marshall/Meeker. All in favor.

Deputy Historian Smith submitted her report. Motion made by Marshall/Fort to accept her report, all in favor. CEO Shaver submitted a report. Motion made by Marshall/Meeker to accept his report, all in favor. Highway Superintendent Kiehn reported that they had been working on the walking trail, the concrete sidewalk had been completed in front/side of the municipal building. Kiehn also mentioned the interior door handles of the municipal building should be changed to push bars to be code compliant. All in favor. Kiehn also mentioned he would be storing the Indian carving stone until spring.

Supervisor Stepanski said that no action would need to be taken for Local Law B of 2023 as it was not needed. Supervisor Stepanski also had a Budget Mod to transfer monies. Motion made by Marshall/Meeker to accept the Budget Mod with a Roll Call Vote: Fort: Yes; Marshall: Yes; Meeker: Yes; Shea: Yes; Stepanski: Yes.

Motion was made by Marshall/Meeker to adopt the 2024 Budget with a Roll Call Vote: Fort: Yes; Marshall: Yes; Meeker: Yes; Shea: Yes; Stepanski: Yes.

Motion made by Marshall/Meeker to pay bills. All in favor.

Meeting adjourned at 8:05 pm on motion of Marshall/Meeker. All in favor.
