Public communications: Supervisor Stepanski had letters from Attorney Langey to Fred Samel/Stockbridge Stone Products in regards to recent blasting and the late notice in receiving the 24 hour blast notice and the response from their Attorney Michael Fogel stating there was an issue with emails bouncing back and the Samel's would be contacting every parcel within 3000 feet to update their contact information before they blast again.

Supervisor Stepanski also had a letter regarding the DEC angler signage for near the creek. Stepanski said he had also received an email in regards to the Solar Farm requesting to apply herbicide, Attorney Langey advised them to appear before the Planning Board again with their request. Stepanski also had an email with a complaint against the Dog Warden, Sheila Garrett, and would be investigating further.

CEO Shaver submitted his July report, motion made by Marshall/Meeker to accept his report, all in favor.

Highway Superintendent Kiehn said the RAM pickup needed repairs to the rearend and would be about \$1100 to repair. Kiehn also said they would be oil & stoning Stockbridge Hill Road on Thursday, weather permitting and would be starting their third round of roadside mowing, have done weed eating around the fire hydrants and water tanks three times and noticed plugs in the Sullivan Road tank.
