The regular monthly meeting called to order at 7:30 PM by Supervisor Stepanski with the following people present: Councilman Fort, Lagoy, Marshall, Meeker, Pete Kiehn, Beth Lamb, Nicole Lafave, Corey Graves and Will Anderson.

After the Pledge of Allegiance, minutes of the January 6th meeting were read and approved on motion of Marshall/Meeker, all in favor. Financial report was accepted on a motion of Marshall/Meeker. All in favor.

Public comments: Beth Lamb/Nicole Lafave, from Stockbridge Valley Central School, attended to talk about their bus referendum for the purchase of 1 – 65 passenger school bus and 1 – 30 passenger school bus. Corey Graves/Beth Lamb discussed the capital project's progress, the improvements that have been done to the school since last year, new programs being offered and the school's budget and trying to stay under the tax cap. Voting will be March 11th from Noon until 8 pm in the school foyer.

Public Communications: Supervisor Stepanski had a thank you note from Mercy Flight thanking the Town for the donation. Stepanski also had the GML from Madison County Planning Board for the proposed cell phone tower for the Board to review.

Supervisor Stepanski had Deputy Historian Celeste Smith's report. Motion made by Marshall/Meeker to accept Smith's report, all in favor. CEO Shaver did not submit a report. Highway Superintendent Kiehn said he had nothing to report and that he would like to put the Asphalt paving bids out to be opened at the March meeting.

New Business: Supervisor Stepanski had the Water Collector Agreement for the Board to approve, which allows Cami to perform duties for the Stockbridge Water District, motion made by Marshall/Meeker to accept the Water Collector Agreement with a Roll Call Vote: Fort: Yes; Lagoy: Yes; Marshall: Yes; Meeker: Yes; Stepanski: Yes.

Supervisor Stepanski also had an Agreement from Costello, Cooney & Fearon which allows the Town to utilize legal services from their offices. Motion made by Marshall/Fort to accept the Agreement, all in favor.

Motion was made by Marshall/Meeker to pay bills. All in favor.
