Public Communications: Supervisor Stepanski had the 2024 Water Quality Report for the Board to review; Stepanski also updated the Board on the Boil Water Order; Stepanski also had information for the Board from Madison County Emergency Management regarding a fire protection seminar at SVCS April 10 at 7 pm; Stepanski also had an email from Madison County Highway Department regarding road closures on Valley Mills Road in April; Stepanski said he and Cami had met with a member of the Department of Labor informing the Town that any contractors that perform work for the Town must be registered with the Department of Labor and gave information on how to access where to find that information. Stepanski also had information on dog license renewals from Cami; Stepanski also informed the Board about an ongoing issue with a neighboring parcel to the Town property; Stepanski also had the resignation letter from Ann Marie Meeker from the Board of Assessment Review.
