

May 5, 2025

The regular monthly meeting called to order at 7:30 PM by Supervisor Stepanski with the following people present: Councilman Fort, Lagoy, Marshall, Meeker, Pete Kiehn, Sam Reeder, Evan and Nathan Ellerbruch.

After the Pledge of Allegiance, minutes of the April 7th meeting were read and approved on motion of Marshall/Meeker, all in favor. Financial report was accepted on a motion of Marshall/Meeker. All in favor.

Public Communications: Supervisor Stepanski had a thank you note from the Munnsville Fire Department thanking the Town for the donation made in Roland Shea's name. Stepanski also had a copy of the email correspondence with Attorney Langey for the Board to review.

Public comments: Evan Ellerbruch attended to update the Board on his Eagle Scout project. Ellerbruch has met with Highway Superintendent Kiehn to clean up the Skaden cemetery on Peterboro Road. Ellerbruch will be cleaning headstones, repairing the wall, cleaning up brush, filling in holes at the cemetery. Ellerbruch will be raising funds for top soil and other items.

CEO Will Anderson was not present. Highway Superintendent Kiehn said the highway department has been preparing Moore Road for paving and was anticipating to pave in late May. Kiehn would like to add 150 tons to the project total to beef up the road in certain areas, and will still be within budget, all in favor. Kiehn also mentioned that would leave \$60k for oil & stoning upper Haslauer, Mosquito Point and North Quarry and would meet with his Highway Committee before proceeding. Kiehn said he had been in contact with Tracey Road Equipment and the new plow truck will be delivered in late 2025. Kiehn had pricing on a new 2025 ¾ ton pickup to replace the 2018 Ram on state bid. Motion made by Marshall/Fort to replace the 2018 Ram, all in favor.

Old Business: none

New Business: Supervisor Stepanski said NYS is requiring all employees to have an I-9 in their file and is having employees fill them out, if needed.

Motion was made by Marshall/Meeker to pay bills. All in favor.

Meeting adjourned at 7:54 pm on motion of Marshall/Meeker. All in favor.
