The regular monthly meeting called to order at 7:30 PM by Supervisor Stepanski with the following people present: Councilman Fort, Lagoy, Marshall, Meeker, Pete Kiehn and Will Anderson.

After the Pledge of Allegiance, minutes of the August 4<sup>th</sup> meeting were read and approved on motion of Marshall/Lagoy, all in favor. Financial report was accepted on a motion of Marshall/Meeker. All in favor.

Public Communications: Supervisor Stepanski said he received a letter from the school asking permission to once again use Carlon Field for an off-campus location for the buses in case of an emergency, Cami will send a letter giving them permission.

CEO Will Anderson presented his report, motion made by Marshall/Meeker to accept Anderson's report, all in favor. Highway Superintendent Kiehn said Phillips Drive had been paved, roadside mowing was going well after some minor repairs and the new plow truck, that was ordered in 2022, should be delivered in November/December.

New Business: Supervisor Stepanski had a Budget Mod to transfer monies, motion made by Marshall/Meeker to accept the Budget Mod with a Roll Call Vote: Fort: Yes; Lagoy: Yes; Marshall: Yes; Meeker: Yes; Stepanski: Yes. Supervisor Stepanski had the Re-Appointment of Darlene Haflett on the Board of Assessment Review, motion made by Marshall/Meeker to accept the Re-Appointment, all in favor. Stepanski also had a Canine Enumeration for the Board to review. Cami explained that the Dog Warden, Sheila Garrett, would like the Town to do an enumeration. Cami had a sample that will be sent to all homeowners/landlords in early 2026.

Supervisor Stepanski talked to the Board about the water main break on Labor Day and also low/no water pressure for some households on Sept. 7. Stepanski said he has been in contact with Water Superintendent, Jim Chamberlain, and Chamberlain said the low/no water pressure on the 7<sup>th</sup> is due to the pump on Middle Road and will be getting estimates to update the pump.

Motion was made by Marshall/Meeker to pay bills. All in favor.
