LOCAL LAW NO. 2 FOR THE YEAR 2018

**A LOCAL LAW DISQUALIFYING ANY PERSON DURING THE PERIOD
OF HIS/HER CANDIDACY FOR ELECTIVE PUBLIC OFFICE FROM APPOINTMENT OR
CONTINUED EMPLOYMENT AS AN EMPLOYEE OF THE
COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS**

BE IT ENACTED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Madison as follows:

Section 1. The Madison County Board of Elections shall have and exercise all the powers and duties conferred or imposed upon it by the election law or any other applicable law.

Section 2. The appointment of members of the Madison County Board of Elections shall be provided by the Election Law.

Section 3. Any person who shall become a candidate for elective public office shall be disqualified during the period of his or her candidacy from the appointment of continued employment from the Board of Elections. The period of his or her candidacy shall be deemed to commence with the filing with the Board of Elections of a nominating or designating petition in furtherance of his or her candidacy unless he or she shall promptly file with the Board a written declination of candidacy. The term "elective public office": shall not be deemed to include any political party office or position. The term "employment" shall include periods of leave of absence and sick time and shall not encompass periods of paid vacation or compensatory time where the employee has submitted his/her resignation effective as the last day of such paid vacation or compensatory time, or combination thereof.

Section 4. This Local Law shall take effect upon the filing with the Office of the Secretary of State.
