The Madison County Healthy Start Partnership is celebrating World Breastfeeding Week, August 1-7, with a special event on Friday, August 3 from 12-3 pm at Breastfeeding Connections Café at Oneida Healthcare's baby weigh station located at 607 Seneca Avenue in Oneida. New or expectant moms and their young children and guests are invited to attend. There will be lunch, hand and shoulder massages, a photograph booth, and giveaways. Moms can talk with other moms, staff from community organizations, and have their baby weighed.

Breastfeeding Connections is a baby weigh station open on Mondays from 5:30-7:00 pm and Fridays from 1-3 pm. The Café is held on the first and third Fridays of the month and includes a light lunch and a space for moms to connect with other moms.
