Safe Pill Drop Off and Document Shredding Day

Canastota, NY - Madison County residents are invited to attend a free Safe Pill Drop Off and Document Shredding event on Saturday, September 22, 2018 from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at the former Reuse Store at the Madison County Landfill site on Buyea Road in Canastota.

Households can dispose of prescription drugs, over-the-counter medications, and veterinary medicines at no charge. All medicine *must* be in its original container and it should *not* be combined with other medications.

Residents may also bring *up to three boxes* of personal and confidential documents to be shredded and recycled. Medical documents, bank information, tax records, and other paperwork containing account numbers or private details are ideal for drop off.

Last year, more than 300 pounds of medication were collected and over eight tons of documents were shredded and recycled during the April and September events.

The event is co-sponsored by the Madison County Department of Solid Waste and Sanitation, Madison County Sheriff's Office and BRIDGES/MCCASA.

Residents unable to make it to the September 22 event can still drop off medications at kiosks located in the following locations:

- **Department of Motor Vehicles** Lobby at the County Office Building in Wampsville (8:30 a.m.- 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday)
- **Department of Social Services** Lobby on North Court Street in Wampsville (9 a.m. – 5 p.m., Monday through Friday)
- **Chittenango Police Department** on Genesee Street in Chittenango (8:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday)
- **New York State Police Troop D Headquarters** on Route 5 in Oneida (24 hours a day, 7 days a week).
- **Hamilton Police Department** on Wings Way in Hamilton (24 hours a day, 7 days a week).
