Flu season is just around the corner. Madison County Health Department is now offering flu vaccines at their Immunization Clinics. Also, make sure your children are up to date on all of their vaccines.

Clinics are held at the Madison County Health Department, 138 N. Court St., Building 5, Wampsville and are by appointment.

Vaccines are available for the following: Flu, Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, Rotavirus, Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis (whooping cough), Haemophilus Influezae type b, Polio, Pneumococcal conjugate, Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Varicella (Chicken Pox), Human Papilloma Virus (HPV), Meningitis, and Shingles.
