### **Madison County encourages Governor to reinstate AIM funding**

**Wampsville, NY** – The Madison County Board of Supervisors has released a statement asking Governor Andrew Cuomo to eliminate the cuts to Aid and Incentives to Municipalities funding. The Governor’s proposed budget presents this cut as a painless way for the state to save \$60 million. However, many municipalities across the state and here in Madison County rely heavily on that funding to fill budget gaps.

“On behalf of the Madison County Board of Supervisors we encourage Governor Cuomo to reinstate the AIM funding,” said Madison County Chairman John M. Becker. “There are several municipalities within Madison County that rely on those funds. The towns affected will have major difficulty meeting the proposed permanent 2% tax cap or properly serving their constituents if these funds are stripped away.”
