

This Indenture, made the twenty-third day of April in the year eighteen hundred and ninety one
Between Right Reverend Bernard J McQuaid of the City of Rochester State of New York, sole surviving
joint-tenant and legatee of Right Reverend Francis McNierney late Bishop of the Diocese of Albany, NY
of the first part, and "St Patrick's Church Chittenango New York of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, in consideration of One Dollar, lawful money of the
United States, paid by the party of the second part, do hereby grant and release unto the said party of
the second part, its successors and assigns, forever, All that tract of parcel of land situate in the town of
Sullivan, County of Madison and State of New York bounded and described as follows. Bounded on the
east and south by the highway known and called "The Old Salt Springs Road", on the west by lands
formerly owned by Joseph Sanger now deceased, and on the north and east by lands of Jacob Stisser,
containing two acres of land be the same more or less. This conveyance is executed to the party of the
second part in trust for the congregation and Society of the Catholic Church of Chittenango for the
purpose of a cemetery and for no other purpose. Party of the first part reserves out of the above
premises burial lots for James Ryan, Phillip Lynch, Phillip Bennett, Christopher Bennett, Ann Dougherty
and Catherine Lee. Said lots to be selected by them and each of them after the grounds are laid out.
Being the premises conveyed by Mary O. Brinkerhoff to said party of the first part by deed bearing date
the fourteenth day of April 1875 and recorded in the office of the Clerk of Madison County April 17,
1875 in Liber 137 of Deeds, at page 29.
