RE: Activate Canal and North Court St. Traffic Light

The next step in the road construction project on North Court Street in Wampsville is to activate the traffic light at the Canal and North Court St. intersection, according to Richard Cary, resident engineer.

On Tuesday, January 23, Syracuse Signal Systems will activate the signal at the Canal and North Court street intersection (near Coleman's bar). "It will be a four way stop with all directions set to red flashing lights on Tuesday and Wednesday," said Cary.

"On Thursday, January 25 we will change from flashing red (a four-way stop) to the new three-color signal. The temporary four-way stop allows the motoring public a chance to adjust to stopping for the light on the Court Street legs prior to the Canal Street legs having a green light."

The Pedestrian beacons on North Court St. near the Otto Shortell Middle School and in front of the Madison County Court House will also be activated next week.

The North Court St. road construction project began on July 18, 2006 and will be completed in the spring of 2007.
