RE: **April 30, 2011** – Two Events -- Free Shredding & Safe Pill Collection

The Madison County Dept. of Solid Waste and Sanitation is hosting two major events on Saturday, April 30, 2011 – A Safe Pill Collection and FREE Shredding of confidential documents -- from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at the main Landfill site on Buyea Rd. in the Town of Lincoln – just 3 miles south of the traffic light on Rte. 5 in Wampsville.

“Those attending these events are asked to follow the signs and obey traffic directions given by RSVP Volunteers and Landfill personnel who will be on hand to direct residents to the FREE shredding event and the Safe Pill Collection being conducted simultaneously on Saturday, April 30 at the landfill site.

Solid Waste Director Jim Zecca, Recycling Coordinator Sharon Driscoll, two Madison County Sheriff’s Deputies, RSVP Director Mary Bartlett and Sarah Johnson of Madison County’s Promise along with the crew from Confidata of Utica will be on hand to assist residents interested in taking advantage of both or either of these worthwhile services.

Residents dropping off prescription drugs are asked to please keep the medications in their original containers; personal information can be crossed out. Those attending the **FREE** shredding event can shred up to three cubic feet (3 file boxes) of confidential material on site.
