The Madison County Mental Health Department provides many services to Madison County residents, from within the department itself, and from other agencies it helps to coordinate.

This brochure lets you know what we provide, and how and where to get help.

Under the Madison County Mental Health Department's umbrella are the Alcohol and Drug Abuse Prevention and Treatment Program (ADAPT), Cedar House and the Mental Health Clinic.

One call can put you in touch with someone who knows how to get the help you need, for you, a family member, friend or loved one.

As the designated local authority under the Mental Hygiene Law, the Mental Health Department helps to coordinate state certified programs provided by Madison-Cortland ARC, Heritage Farm, BRiDGES, Liberty Resources, Consumer Services of Madison County, ARISE at the Farm and Upstate Cerebral Palsy.

Alcohol and Drug Abuse Prevention and Treatment (ADAPT): 366-2327

- ✓ Individual and group therapy
- ✓ Early recovery group
- ✓ Aftercare group
- ✓ Intensive outpatient program
- ✓ Specialized services, such as teen group, aggression-reduction, HIV/AIDS workshop, MICA services (addresses needs of mentally ill chemical abusers)

Cedar House: 361-8413

- ✓ Day treatment/clubhouse
- ✓ Socialization and pre-job help for Madison County residents with severe emotional problems
- ✓ Help to return to your community
- ✓ Homelike environment with training for work, learning personal budgeting, assertiveness and how to live among others
- ✓ Therapy for families offered, as well as for individuals

Madison-Cortland ARC – respite, day services, vocational training, case management, and residential care for people with developmental disabilities: **363-3389**

Liberty Resources – provides multiple services to individuals with mental illness, with developmental disabilities, and with alcoholism and chemical dependency – offering residential care, vocational and skills training, and adult case management: **425-1004**

Heritage Farm – at a unique farm setting provides case management, respite, vocational and day services for individuals with developmental disabilities and their families: **893-1889**
