

## **PART-TIME COOK OPENING**

The Madison County Sheriff's Office currently has one opening for a permanent part-time Cook at the Madison County Correctional Facility, located in Wampsville, NY, providing meals for up to 120 inmates per meal. The work involves preparing and cooking a variety of foods. The work is performed under the general supervision of a supervisor and performs related work as required.

Work week consist of at least twenty one hours per week. Benefits consist of health and dental insurance, paid time off as well as other per contract. 2013 Hire Rate: \$15.47/hr.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:** (A) One (1) year of full-time paid experience, or its part-time equivalent, in large scale food preparation; OR (B) Two (2) years of full-time paid experience, or its part-time equivalent, in assisting in large scale cooking; OR (C) Completion of thirty (30) semester credit hours from a regionally accredited college or university or one accredited by the New York State Board of Regents to grant degrees in culinary arts, food service or a closely related field; OR ((D) Graduation from a secondary or post secondary vocational/technical institute with a certificate in culinary arts, food service/preparation or a closely related field; OR (E) An equivalent combination of training and experience as defined by the limits of (A),(B), (C), and (D) above.

**NOTE:** Large-scale food preparation to be defined as experience in the actual preparation of food by means of roasting, baking or broiling in hospitals, schools, nursing homes, hotels, restaurants, correctional facilities or military service.
