Madison Hamilton Plank Road Co.	Stockholders	Abandonment of that portion of the road extending from the Park House, Hamilton Village, to the south line of the town of Madison.	1859
Manlius & Delphi Plank Road Co.	Stockholders	Abandonment of the south portion of the road in Madison County.	1858
Oriskany Falls to Hamilton	James Coolidg (Coolidge)	Survey	1850
The Third Great Western Turnpike Road	The President Directors & Company of the Third Great Wester Turnpike Road Co. v. Thomas C. Nye	Nye drove stage coaches between Cherry Valley and Manlius at an agreed reduced toll rate to be paid monthly. In May of 1847 Nye ceased operations. Road Co. claims that Nye did not pay tolls for the preceeding two and a third months.	1849
The Third Great Western Turnpike Road	The President Directors & Company of the Third Great Wester Turnpike Road Co. v. Edwin D. Loomis	Loomis failed to pay \$0.30 in tolls, claimed that the road was not properly inspected and in disrepair. Judgment for Road Co. in the amount of \$5.30.	1859
The Third Great Western Turnpike Road	The President Directors & Company of the Third Great Wester Turnpike Road Co. v. John Phillipps	Judgment for Road Co. in the amount of \$133.55.	1860
