CPF Trails

Enjoy hiking, snow shoeing and cross country skiing in this 125-acre Madison County Park. The two main trails: an orange blazed 1 mile trail and another 0.6 mile trail offer a panoramic view stretching across the Oneida Lake and a 100-foot waterfall. The park also features a softball field, picnic pavilions, a disc-golf course and a restroom facility powered by a micro-hydro (renewable energy) system!

The Gorge Trail is an old railroad bed that extends over 2 miles north along Chittenango Creek from the Village of Cazenovia. This trail serves as a portion of the North County Trail/Link Trail and is a favorite of walkers and cross country skiers. Access from Clark St. (south) and Bingley Rd. (north). The Burlingame Trail system includes approximately 7 miles of wooded trails with a parking area on Burlingame Road 1 mile west of Route 13. Fairchild Hill offers over 2 miles of meadow trails with views of Cazenovia Lake. Access and parking behind the brown building at the south end of Cazenovia Lake. Along 2.5 miles of the Lehigh Valley Railroad, the South Trail is open to the public from Ballina Road south to New Woodstock. Access is off Ballina, Thompson or Delhi Road about 1/2 mile east of Route 13, and at the southern end from the New Woodstock Lumber parking area. Carpenter's Pond Trail in the Village of Cazenovia is a pleasant walk around the pond and along Chittenango Creek. Main entrance at Carpenter's Street. Between Ballina and Thompson roads, the trail crosses Chittenango Creek on an historic trestle bridge. In addition to CPF trails, Nelson Swamp Unique Area, NYS DEC state land, features a 0.7-mile Interpretive Trail which is handicap accessible. Nelson Swamp is home to 400 vascular plants and 105 species of breeding birds.
