Below please find the questions and responses that have been received on this project.

Q: What is the proposed span of each structure?

A: The span lengths will be primarily dictated by NYSDEC and US Army Corps permit requirements but other factors could include the proposed roadway alignment and existing bridge spans.

Q: There are references regarding all the work being completed using Microstation? Will an AutoCAD or equal design not be acceptable? Will we need to supply CAD files when completed?

A: AutoCAD is acceptable for design however the final plans must be able to be converted to MICROSTATION for submission to the County as CAD files will be required.

Q: The Cover sheet of the RFP Says "Professional Engineering Services for Design and Construction Inspection of Bridges" and the scope of the RFP does not mention the Construction Inspection service. Can you clarify if the Construction Inspection is included in the proposal?

A: The Construction Inspection is covered under "Construction Support" in the project scope. No additional CI is included in this RFP.

Q: "The South Court Street bridge new roadway alignment" – Is the County thinking of moving the bridge location along Court Street in such a way to realign the stream under the bridge with better attack angle for the stream or, since the house will be demolished, would the county realign Clockville Road intersection to eliminate the deadly-Y intersection as seen from the attached?

A: The realignment of Clockville Road is not included within the scope of this RFP.

Q: What is the funding source for the project?

A: The funding source is local

Q: Are there record plans for these bridges?

A: A map of the area has been attached below for your reference. In addition, we do have some drawings of the existing substructures with very limited detail. These drawings are from the 40's and not able to be copied so viewing is only available at the Highway Office.

Q: Has the stream realignment been discussed with the permitting agencies, NYSDEC and USACE?

A: The stream realignments have not been discussed with NYSDEC or USACE.

Q: What is the expectation regarding construction inspection? The RFP states a minimum of three site visits will be required?

A: The Construction Inspection is covered under "Construction Support" in the project scope. No additional CI is included in this RFP.

Q: The County will develop and implement the traffic control plan. Does this mean the plans will not have to show any traffic control?

A: Traffic control does not need to be shown on the drawings provided by the consultant.

Q: The Period of Performance on page 4 refers to an executed agreement in October 2014, while in paragraph c. of the Selection item on page 6 it shows the executed agreement date as November 12, 2014. Which date is correct?

A: November 12, 2014 will be the date of the executed contract.

Q: The RFP Requirements on page 5 refer to the feasibility portion of the project but there is no other mention of the feasibility portion in the RFP. Please clarify.

A: The word Feasibility should be deleted from the sentence. The sentence should be "An estimate of hours and cost for the project, submitted in a separate, sealed envelope."

Q: Can you provide more information regarding the proposed realignment of South Court Street and the new bridge location? Perhaps a graphic if possible.

A: Please see the graphic provided below.

Q: Will the county accept Professional Liability insurance of 2 million for each occurrence and 2 million Aggregate, or do we have to get the extra coverage?

A: All insurance requirements should be in compliance with the amount requested in the proposal documents.
