In accordance with the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Act of 1981, as amended, the State of New York invites comments on the proposed New York State Plan for the 2014 – 2015 Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP).

A copy of the plan is also available for review at the local Departments of Social Services for all counties outside of NYC and at the NYC Human Resources Agency for counties within NYC.

Persons who have pre-registered will be called upon to speak first. Others will be called in the order in which they register.

Speakers must limit their testimony to five minutes and must submit three written copies of their statements.
