HOW IT WORKS

FREE
No Drop Off Fee

MULCH & THIN FILMS

- Collect & store your Agricultural plastics at your farm
- Store as listed on right
- Drop off at the Madison County Landfill site or transfer stations for **Free**

- Cut into pieces
- Brush or shake to remove debris
- Roll and fold dry films into bundles



HIGH TUNNELS & HOOPHOUSE COVERS

WHY RECYCLE AG PLASTICS

- Save money on your farm
By recycling ag plastic as it's **FREE**
- Help the environment by keeping plastic out of landfills

- Cut into small sections
- Dimensions will depend on thickness and flexibility of film

DROP OFF LOCATIONS

Wed. & Sat. - 7:10a.m.- 3:00 p.m.

Sullivan Transfer Station

Bolivar Rd.
Fri. & Sat. - 7:10 a.m.-3:00 p.m.

- Stack pots & Trays: Knock out loose soil
- Keep dry. Tie onto pallet



STORING PLASTIC

- **Store under cover:** Keep as clean and dry as possible - e.g., store on pallets in barn, trailer, hay wagon or outside under a tarp.
- **Do not mix different types of products.** Separate clean films from dirtier.
