

Getting to the Madison County Landfill

From Oneida - Route 5 headed West

1. At “Five Corners” / Wal-Mart/ west of Oneida turn left (south) on to Upper Lenox Ave.
2. Go 1.3 miles and take the second right on to Upper Lenox Road. Follow signs.
3. Go 0.2 miles to the STOP sign and turn left on to Clockville Road. Follow signs.
4. Go 0.1 miles (around a sharp curve to the right) and take second left on to Buyea Road/County Route 54. Follow signs.
5. Go up steep hill, bear left to stay on Buyea Road/County Route 54 and go 1.6 miles to find the landfill and the Solid Waste Office on the right.

From Canastota - Route 5 headed East

1. At the traffic light in Wampsville, turn right on to South Court Street/County Route 54.
2. Go 1.4 miles (around a sharp curve to the right) and take second left up Buyea Road/County Route 54. Follow signs.
3. Continue up steep hill, bear left to stay on Buyea Road/County Route 54 and go 1.6 miles to find the landfill and the Solid Waste Office on the right.

From Morrisville - NYS Route 20

1. At the traffic light in the center of Morrisville, turn on Cedar Street/Swamp Road/County Route 101.
2. Go about 5 miles pass SUNY Morrisville Equine Center and Morrisville - Eaton High School to Peterboro.
3. At the STOP sign by the park in Peterboro, turn right.
4. Go about 0.2 miles and turn left on to Buyea Road/County Route 54 after you cross the creek.
5. Go about five miles until you go down a steep hill. The landfill and the Solid Waste Office are on the left.

Directions to Madison County Landfill from NYS Thruway (I-90)

1. Take Exit 34 from the Thruway. (Canastota & Boxing Hall of Fame Exit)
2. After going thru the toll booth, turn left on to Peterboro Street/NYS Route 13 and go thru the Village of Canastota.
3. Go about 1.3 miles to the traffic signal at the junction of NYS Route 13 and NYS Route 5.
4. Turn left on NYS Route 5 and go about 2.3 miles to traffic signal in Wampsville.
5. Turn right at the Wampsville light onto South Court Street/County Route 54.
6. Go 1.6 miles on South Court Street/County Route 54 and turn left onto Buyea Road/County Route 54. There is a sign here indicating that the County Landfill is up the hill.
7. A short distance up the hill Buyea Road bears to the left. Be sure to stay on Buyea.
8. Go a total of 1.6 miles on Buyea Road to the Solid Waste Office (beige building on the right side of the road).
