

Textiles - Any textile item, even if it's worn, torn, or stained, can be recycled as long as it is clean and dry. Textile recycling how to:

Place textiles in a sealed clear plastic bag. Set out next to or on top of recycling bin for curbside pick up. Or bring to your local transfer station. Blankets, sheets, sleeping bags are okay to recycle.

Residents can also donate used textiles to the Rescue Mission at the Madison County ReUse Store located at the main landfill on Buyea Rd.

Recycle Used Textiles!

Textiles are clothing, linens, bedding, curtains, and other items. **Any textile item, even if it's worn, torn, or stained, can be Recycled as long it is clean and dry.**

The Environmental Protection Agency estimates that the average person throws away **70 pounds** of clothing per year.

Textile Recycling How to ...

- Place textiles in a sealed clear plastic bag
- Set out next to or on top of recycling bin for curbside pick up
 - Bring to your local transfer station
- Blankets, sheets or sleeping bags are okay
 - Buttons and zippers are okay too!
