

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
COUNTY OF MADISON**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that pursuant to County Law Section 268 and pursuant to a resolution of the Madison County Board of Supervisors dated February 10, 2015, there shall be presented to the Board of Supervisors of the County of Madison, New York, a map and plan, prepared by Dunn & Sgromo Engineers, PLLC, competent engineers duly licensed by the State of New York, relating to the construction of additional trunk and sewer laterals within the existing boundaries of the Madison County Sewer District and the Village of Cazenovia. The location of these Madison County Sewer District improvements will begin approximately near the U.S. Route 20 intersection with Carriage Lane in the Village of Cazenovia and continue south and east of U.S. Route 20. It is anticipated that the estimated cost of the proposed sewer improvements will not exceed Two Hundred Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$200,000.00). The above referenced map and plan (including the detailed estimate of anticipated expenses) is on file at the Madison County Board of Supervisors Clerk's Office located on the second floor of County Office Building No. 4 at 138 North Court Street Wampsville, New York 13163 for inspection by all interested persons during normal business hours.

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that the Board of Supervisors determined this action to be an Unlisted Action for purposes of SEQRA, declared itself lead agency, identified the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation and the New York State Department of Transportation as involved agencies and the Village of Cazenovia, Town of Cazenovia and Town of Nelson as interested agencies, and directed the preparation of a short environmental assessment form; and

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that the Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing as to the map and plan, the construction of the proposed sewer improvements within the Madison County Sewer District and the estimated cost thereof at the Supervisor's Chambers located on the second floor of County Office Building No. 4 at 138 North Court Street, Wampsville, New York 13163 on March 10, 2015 at 2:15 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, at which time all persons interested will be heard.
