Be it enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Madison as follows:

SECTION 1. Local Law #1 of 2013 amending Local Law #4 of 2008 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3: Qualifications: At the time of appointment, the County Administrator shall have the following training and/o experience:

- (A) A Master's degree in Public Administration, Business Administration or a closely related field and at least five (5) years of full-time progressively responsible administrative experience which shall have included supervisory responsibilities and two (2) years assisting in municipal budget management; or
- (B) A Bachelor's degree in Public Administration, Business Administration or a closely related field and at least seven (7) years of the experience described in (A); or
- (C) A Bachelor's degree and at least nine (9) years of experience as described in (A); or
- (D) Graduation from high school or possession of an equivalency diploma and at least fifteen (15) years of the experience described in (A); or
- (E) An equivalent combination of education and experience as outlined by (A) and (D).

SECTION 2. This amendment to Local Law #4 of 2008 shall be effective immediately.
